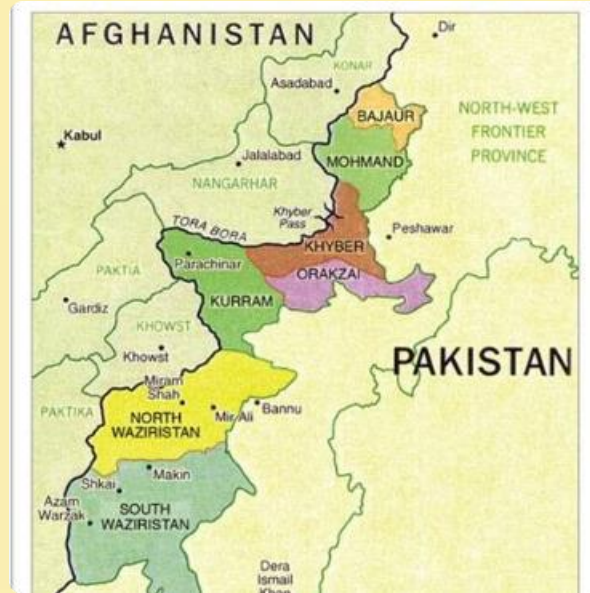


Temporary Displaced Persons Emergency Recovery Project

Objectives and Outreach



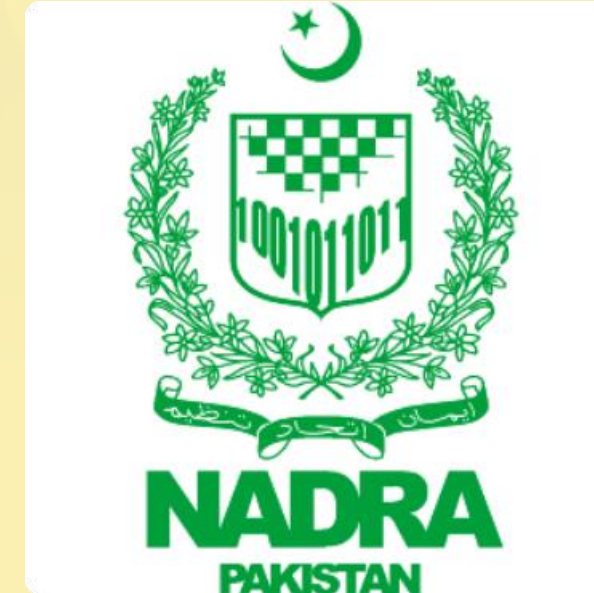
Outreach of Program

The program was rolled out in in North Waziristan, South Waziristan, Khyber, Kurram, and Orakzai districts in 2016. The The program has been further further expanded to Mohmand Mohmand and Bajaur districts. districts.



Objectives

The program focuses on providing unconditional cash cash transfer to displaced families to cover their basic needs, promoting child health health awareness, and strengthening emergency response safety net delivery systems.



Collaborative Partnerships Partnerships

The project is being carried out in out in collaboration with NADRA NADRA to achieve impactful outcomes.

Key Components

Emergency Recovery Package

One time Return and Resettlement Grant of Rs. **35,000**.

Livelihood support grant of Rs. **16,000** over period of 4 months to TDP families



Child Wellness Package

Five installments of Rs. **2,500** paid upon attendance of a Health Awareness Session. This component has improved the immunization, screening and referral of malnourished children (ages 0-24 months)



Technical Assistance

Administration of cash transfers through systems development, capacity building, stakeholder consultation monitoring and strategic communication.



Services Offered



NADRA Registration Center

National Identity Card (NIC) NIC (Overseas Pakistanis) Family Registration Certificate, Child Registration Certificate, Juvenile Card, and Arms License.



Civil Registration

Services offered include Birth Certificates, Death Certificates, Marriage Certificates, Divorce Certificates.



NADRA Financial Service Platform

Various services including Utility bill payments, Mobile top-ups, ID Verification, Excise & Taxation Islamabad, Naya Pakistan Housing Project.

ATM Machines and Banking Services.
